MOVED: Upon review and advice of ARRL's Connecticut Corporate Counsel Day Pitney, and from review and revision of the existing ARRL Articles of Association and Bylaws by the working group of the Executive Committee; therefore, be it known that By Laws 8, 9 and 10 are hereby amended as follows:

Life Membership

8. Life Membership in the League is available upon payment of twenty-five times the annual dues rates set forth above.

9. Life Membership is not transferable.

10. Should a Life Member who paid dues at a multiple of the special rate established in By-Law 7 cease to be eligible for the special rate, his membership shall cease and the amount paid shall be creditable toward a Life Membership, including receipt of *QST*, at the then-current rate.

Rationale: Analysis of actuaries show a trend of diminishing returns on life memberships that are perpetuated. It is management's suggestion that we no longer continue this practice. The cut-off date is to allow those members that have already purchased life membership to maintain the terms of the original sale agreement.

Cost: Printing of new membership applications should be minimal if timed correctly, and minimal IT time for updates on website which could be performed as routine maintenance.
